## *Guidelines for Submitting an Abstract*

1. The abstract of the proposed paper should be approximately 150 to 200 words and in sufficient detail for evaluation purposes.
2. Speakers are encouraged not to limit themselves to just the Suggested Topics – we want your ideas!
3. Sessions will be 50 minutes in total length. It may be possible to schedule two back-to-back sessions if your topic requires additional time. We can be flexible!
4. Papers must address the subject so listeners can immediately use the information.
5. A Conference Proceedings may not be provided. Speakers are encouraged to bring copies of their presentations as handouts, and to provide copies electronically to interested attendees after the conference.
6. Papers submitted for the Migration, Homesteading, and System Management Track should be non-commercial – i.e., discuss strategies, issues etc. Particular applications are appropriate only if they demonstrate principles of general interest.
7. Descriptions of specific commercial programs are appropriate only if the paper is being submitted for the Technical Demo track.
8. Papers concerning products or programs must include the availability of the program (by commercial sale, through CSL, etc.).
9. Abstracts may be submitted by mail, fax, or e-mail. (Electronic submission is encouraged.)
10. E-mailed abstracts: all requested information must be provided for your paper to be considered.
11. Mailed or faxed abstracts: please use the provided abstract submission form. All sections of the form must be filled out for your paper to be considered. Copies of the form are acceptable.
12. Material submitted for consideration, including diskettes, will not be returned.
